

Dr. Melanie-Préjean Sullivan has been the Director of Campus Ministry at Bellarmine University in Louisville, Kentucky since 2000. She holds master's degrees in history, in counseling/student affairs, and in theological studies. Before becoming a campus minister, she was an archivist, a museum collections manager, and a high school humanities teacher and counselor. A graduate of St. Meinrad School of Theology and Louisville Presbyterian Theological Seminary, Dr. Prejean's doctoral research focused on ways in which undergraduate students learn to articulate their own theologies and to observe the working of the Spirit in their lives
